34th Annual Ozark Quilt Fair

When: Saturday, September 10, 2011, 10:00 a.m.–2:00 p.m. There is no rain date. If weather is questionable, call 479-799-4274 to find out if the fair will take place.

Cost: \$10.00 for exhibitors; free to the viewing public.

Rules: **All quilts must be quilted or tied by hand or by home sewing machine—no long-arm or commercial quilting.** Tops may be pieced, embroidered, or appliquéd (machine piecing is acceptable). No other forms of needlework are to be exhibited or sold (i.e., no crochet, cross-stitch, knitting, etc.).

Antique as well as new quilts are welcome. Quilts displayed may be for sale. All quilts should include a label indicating price if the quilt is for sale, and history of the quilt (creator, residence, date, pattern, etc.).

Registration forms must be turned in to the museum by **Wednesday, September 7.**

Exhibits: Ropes will be stretched between trees for hanging quilts. Each exhibitor may plan to use up to 15 feet of the ropes, unless space and number of quilters in attendance allow more or less. Feel free to bring lawn chairs and card tables if you need extra display space.

Security: The Shiloh Museum staff and volunteers will be at the event all day, but YOU are the best security for your quilts.

Food: Each entrant will receive a free sack lunch (sandwich, chips, drink). Additional lunches may be pre-ordered for \$5 each.

Awards: Viewer's Choice awards will be given in both new and antique quilt categories. First prize in each category is \$50, second prize, \$35, third prize, \$15. Awards will be presented at 2:00 p.m.
